



Day 1

- * Arrival and checking in of the participants in Hostel Feri, located on the Olympic mountain Igman.
- * Dinner and a welcome drink, along with the brief presentation of the following program and activities.

Day 2

- * Breakfast.
- * Departure and visit to Sarajevo.
- * Sightseeing of Baščaršija accompanied by a professional guide who will reveal the beauties in the heart of the Old town. A visit to the Museum of Sarajevo 1878-1918 which is situated just a few steps away from the famous Princip's Bridge.
- * The tour will be continued by visiting religious institutions: Gazi Husref-bey's Mosque, Congregational Church of the Holy Mother, Cathedral of Jesus' Heart.
- * Free time for individual sightseeing of the Old town, shopping, and enjoying in rich and wealthy

gastro offer in one of many traditional restaurants.

- * A visit to the famous and well known war Tunnel (Dobrinja-Butmir), a symbol of salvation of town Sarajevo in the worst war years.
- * Return to the hostel.
- * In the evening hours, the participants can enjoy themselves around a campfire and a traditional cuisine till late in the niaht.



Day 3

- * Breakfast.
- * After breakfast the bus will leave for Herzegovina.
- * Arrival to Mostar in the afternoon hours and a sightseeing
- one of local restaurant, situated at the side of the emerald coloured river Neretva.
- * The tour will be continued by visiting: Blagaj and the khangah on Buna (a khangah built in the classic Turkish baroque style and as such unique in BiH), Kravica waterfalls (it's located in a surreal natural scenery nearby Ljubuško), the tour will end in Počitelj (the historical settlement with Oriental-Mediterranean character at the banks of the river Neretva).

- * Departure for Sarajevo in the late afternoon hours.
- * 19.00 Arrival in hostel Feri.
- * Dinner.
- * Evening of BiH film in Hostel Feri.

Day 4

- * Breakfast.
- * Departure of the bus towards the Olympic mountain Bjelašnica in the early morning hours.
- * Arrival to Babin do and a circular drive with a ski lift to the top of Bjelašnica, from where you will have an breathtaking view of the wonderful landscapes and panorama of the intact nature of Igman and Bjelašnica.
- * After returning to Babin do, the tour will be continued towards the traditional Bosnian etno village Umoljani where you will be warmly greeted by the hospitable hosts. There will be a short stop to the village Šabići in order for the participants to see the medieval bosnian tombstones.
- * Upon the arrival to Umoljani, the participants will visit the oldest mosque in this area, as well as the site Gradina,



where they will learn and hear about local legends and stories.

- * On the way back, the participants will be introduced to the folk costumes of this area and have traditional homemade food at their disposal for lunch.
- * Return to the hostel, dinner.
- * Free activities in the evening.

Itenerary guide:

Day 1 - Arrival in Sarajevo, (transfer to hostel Feri).

Day 2 - Visit to Sarajevo, sightseeing of the Old town.

Day 3 - Mostar and Herzegovina tour.

Day 4 - Visit to etno villages on Bjelašnica.

Day 5 - Visit to Vranduk and Bosnian pyramids.

Day 6 - Departure from hostel Feri & Sarajevo.

What does the program include?

Transfer from the airport or bus station to hostel Feri. Welcome drink, five halfboards, traditional lunch on the fourth day, and packed lunch for the fifth day, accommodation fee and insurance, lunch at the village Umoljani (Bjelašnica), pass for ski lift on Bjelašnica, transportation for the mentioned tour destination (Igman – Sarajevo – Igman, Igman – Mostar – Blagaj – Kravice – Počitelj – Igman, Igman – Bjelašnica – Umoljani – Igman, Igman – Visoko - Igman), services of the professional guide in Sarajevo, Mostar, Bjelašnica and Visoko, pass for the Sarajevo`s Tunnel of salvation, and live music for the last night.

What doesn't the program include?

Lunch during the free time in Sarajevo, Mostar, and other unspecifed localities.

About hostel Feri and mountain Igman:

* Igman is a mountain in central Bosnia and Herzegovina. Located southwest of Sarajevo, surrounded by the mountains Bjelašnica, Visočica and Treskavica.

Igman is a very popular destination for hiking and skiing, with one of the richest concentration of ozone in Europe. During the 14th Winter Olympic Games, Igman was along with Jahorina and Bjelašnica, one of the main battlegrounds for competitors.

* Hostel Feri was opened in December of 2008, and has been built according to the latest international standards, and as so, it belongs to the so-called group "Hostel of the new generation." It's located and surrounded by the beautiful and intact nature of *Veliko Polje*, in the heart of the Olympic mountain Igman.

rendezvous with Bosnia and Herzegovina

This modern hostel has 39 rooms and a capacity of 103 primary and 21 supplementary beds placed in double, triple, quadruple rooms, and one room with 6 beds. Every room has a shower, toilet, satellite TV, high speed internet connection (4096/384 kbps), and direct dial phone.

Most rooms have a balcony with a beautiful view on the nature.

Hostel facilities: restaurant, caffe bar, conference hall, parking, fitness, sauna, recreation center, internet center, courts for beach volleyball, basketball, football, and childrens playground.
